

## COMMON RECYCLING FAQ'S

Are pizza boxes recyclable?

Yes, if they are clean and free of food residue/grease. If dirty, place in the trash.

Can I leave the tops on my plastic containers?

Yes, but please be sure the containers are rinsed out first.

Can I recycle tops from my tin cans?

Yes, but please place them inside the can.

Can I recycle aluminum foil?

Yes, but only if it is clean and free of food residue. If dirty, place in the trash.

Can I recycle window envelopes/tissue boxes/macaroni & spaghetti boxes?

Yes, but please remove the window portion as it is not recyclable.

What about aluminum foil, saran, wax paper boxes?

Yes, if serrated edge is removed.

## AM I RECYCLABLE?

### YES

Aerosol Cans, if empty  
Greeting Cards  
Wrapping Paper  
Canning Jar Lids

### NO

CD/DVD cases  
Candy wrappers  
Paper Plates/Cups  
Plastic silverware  
Soiled tissues/paper towels  
Shaving cream cans  
Disposable razors  
Used vacuum cleaner bags  
Bread bags/Ziploc bags  
Pellet bags  
Plastic Coat Hangers  
Cardboard/Metal Containers  
(ie; Pringles, Cocoa, Crisco)  
Rubber Garden Hoses

### **RECYCLABLE ONLY AT TRANSFER STATIONS (Not Curbside):**

Batteries – Alkaline, Rechargeable, Automotive  
Electronic Scrap – Computers, Printers, TV's, Answering Machines, Scanners, etc.  
Household Thermostats  
Plastic Bags (WalMart, Kinney's, TOPS) or they may be returned to retail/grocery store

### **TAKEN ONLY AT TRANSFER STATIONS AS SCRAP METAL (Not Curbside):**

Refrigerators – Only if freon has been removed  
Stoves, Washers, Dryers  
Vacuum cleaners  
Toasters  
Crock Pots  
Griddles  
Coffee Maker (without the glass carafe)  
or anything with a small electric motor
