The permit applied for with this form applies only to the Building Codes of New York State and has <u>no</u> bearing on the other local, State, or Federal regulations, such as zoning or floodplain ordinance, etc.

The permit fee must be submitted to the Lewis County Building & Codes Office with the completed application. Please make all checks payable to the Lewis County Clerk and mail to the Lewis County Building & Codes Department, 7660 North State Street, Lowville, New York 13367.

The approved permit and all correspondence will be mailed to the owner at the address indicated on the application.

It is the responsibility of the owner to see that the Lewis County Code Enforcement Officer is notified when the project will be ready for the next inspection.

Unless regulated by other laws or regulations, such as Penal Law 405 or Title 12 NYCRR Part 39, the provisions of this chapter shall govern the possession, manufacture, storage, handling, sale and use of explosives, explosive materials, fireworks, and small arms ammunition

Section 105.2 of 2020 Fire Code, no person or entity shall commence, perform, or continue any work that must conform with the Uniform Code and/or Energy Code unless such person or entity has applied for and the authority having jurisdiction has issued a permit authorizing such work

Mandated Documentation

- Site Safety Plan
- Explosives / Fireworks Storage Plan on Site
- \$1,000,000 or higher General Liability Insurance Policy Listing County of Lewis as an additional insured on policy.
- Where applicable ATF Clearance letter & employee possessor list
- It is understood and agreed that the holder of this Permit shall indemnify and hold harmless County of Lewis from and against all losses and claims, demands, payments, suits, actions, recoveries, and judgments of every nature and description brought or recovered against it by reason of any omission or act of the Permittee, its agents, or employees in the execution of the conduct authorized by this Permit. The Permittee shall obtain, maintain, and pay premiums for liability insurance in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 U.S. dollars naming County of Lewis as an additional insured on said policy and with provisions that protect the County of Lewis from contingent liability under this Permit. Proof of such insurance policy or policies shall be attached to the application prior to approval being given.
