Here are responses to questions that have been asked in response to this RFP.

- Who is the current operator of the service? **Birnie Bus Transit is our current Third-Party Operator**
- Is the project fully funded through 5311? **Our system is fully funded through a combination of 5311 and STOA (State Operating Assistance) funding with some local revenue received from bus advertising and contributions by agencies we service. We've also received operational funds through the CARES Act and capital project funds from NYS MEP (Modernization and Enhancement Program) and NYS ATC (Accelerated Transit Capital).**
- What was the total paid to the current operator in 2023? **In 2023, we paid \$1,024,717.45 to our Third-Party Operator**
- How many total buses are being operated on the current service? **Our total peak fleet is 13; 2 wheelchair vans and 11 buses (8 buses owned by LCPT and 3 buses will be ordered with 5311 grant funds in the coming months).**
