

**GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE**  
**May 21, 2024**

Present: Andrea Moroughan, Chair; Josh Leviker, Vice-Chair; Herb Frost; Thomas Kalamas, and Jeffrey Nellenback.

Legislator Moroughan called the meeting to order at 1:02 p.m.

Legislator Kalamas moved to approve the April 16, 2024, committee meeting minutes as recorded, seconded by Legislator Frost, and carried.

Legislator Moroughan began by asking for discussion on the Highway Presentation that Tim Hunt did at the April 16, 2024 Committee meetings. Legislator Leviker thinks that we should continue moving forward with outreach to the Towns. Legislator Moroughan asked how he proposed that we move forward. Legislator Leviker stated that he felt the group should meet with three more Towns before bringing them together as a group to begin putting pen to paper. Tim agreed and said he would start setting up the meetings with the remaining Towns.

The following draft resolutions were reviewed:

1. Introductory Local Law No. 1-2024 titled "A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 2-2021: To Extend the Authorization of 12 and 13 Year Old Licensed Hunters to Hunt Deer with a Firearm or Crossbow during Hunting Season with the Supervision of a Licensed Adult Pursuant to Environmental Conservation Law §11-0935" and setting the public hearing to be held on July 2, 2024 at 5:00 p.m.

2. Appropriating funds from General Contingency to Buildings & Grounds account lines for expenses of maintenance and upkeep of the Glenfield School building. The amount of \$35,000.00 is net of reimbursement that is expected from the Rochester Cornerstone Group who has agreed to pay 50% of the costs, up to \$30,000.00 a year.

3. Appropriating \$572,449.00 from Fund Balance that originally came from FEMA for bridge repair work that was not expended in 2023 but will be in 2024.
