Community Connectors

Paperwork has started on the Martinsburg to Glenfield Community Connection, with public hearings and SEQRs being scheduled to get the connections open this winter with the cooperation of the Town of Martinsburg.

We are also getting closer on our Town of Watson Community Connector, but we still need landowners on Number 4 Road, Pine Grove Road and Greig Road to allow trails on their property so we can open roads for the Community Connectors. We hope to establish a second Black River crossing on the Greig Road to ensure vital access between areas.

Community Connections will be an ongoing process so if you are willing to help, or know someone willing to allow trails, please help us out! This initiative is County wide and we would also like to get landowners to connect Osceola to West Leyden and Boonville!

Trail Ambassadors

TRAIL CREW UPDATES




The Lewis County Trails are closed for the season, but maintenance still continues as weather and landowners allow.

The trail crew have been busy getting the Glenfield School Trail ready for the spring opening. See pictures on the left.



The trail crew has installed the sign posts that the Black River Valley Four Wheelers purchased from the Yamaha Grant. Trail name signs are in, so watch for the improvements on the Middle Road Trails and hopefully we can continue the sign initiative to name the trails and expand our signage.



Lee Gulf Reroute - we meet with NYSDEC and Lewis County Soil and Water to look at the four stream crossing permits needed. A new application with the new requirements requested is being worked on for a 2025 installation.

The NYSDOT permits are in for the Ives Road, Glendale Road and Main Street. We will be working with the Highway Department and NYSDOT to install the trail crossing to NYSDOT standards.

ROUND TABLE UPDATES

The next meeting will be January 27, 2025

ALL TRAILS CLOSED ON OCTOBER 15th

The meeting began with introductions. It was announced that the next meeting would be held on January 27th, following the cancellation of the November and December meetings. The agenda focused on club agreements and the ambassador program, with participants encouraged to provide feedback.

Kristen from Naturally Lewis discussed completing a SOAR analysis on the Lewis County Trail System. It is a strategic planning tool that helps organizations identify and assess their strengths, opportunities, aspirations and results. Attendees discussed the current assets of the trail system and community support and Kristen will finalize a questionnaire that can be sent out to the public with Facebook and emails. To encourage participation it was decided to do a giveaway of two permits from all participants of the survey.

Scott Simmons from Barnes Corners Sno Pals Snowmobile Club shared his vision for promoting Lewis County as a Motorsports destination and the need for collaboration between ATV and snowmobile clubs to enhance tourism and community engagement. Scott proposed the creation of project wish lists to inspire grassroots initiatives. The change in the SNIRT run was discussed with a change to a family-oriented snowmobiling event. It was also discussed, along with the need to define success and measure outcomes.

The meeting concluded with updates on ongoing projects, including NYSDEC permits for Lee Gulf and coordination with NYSDOT and the Highway Department for the road crossing permits. Discussions addressed the legality of using ATVs on snowmobile trails, ATV safety during hunting season, and the revival of community events. Consideration for an appreciation gathering for landowners and trail ambassadors was discussed. The focus remained on collaboration and future planning.

There will not be meetings in November and December due to the holidays but please maintain communication through email and share information.
