

DEMENTIA ORIENTATION WORKSHOP

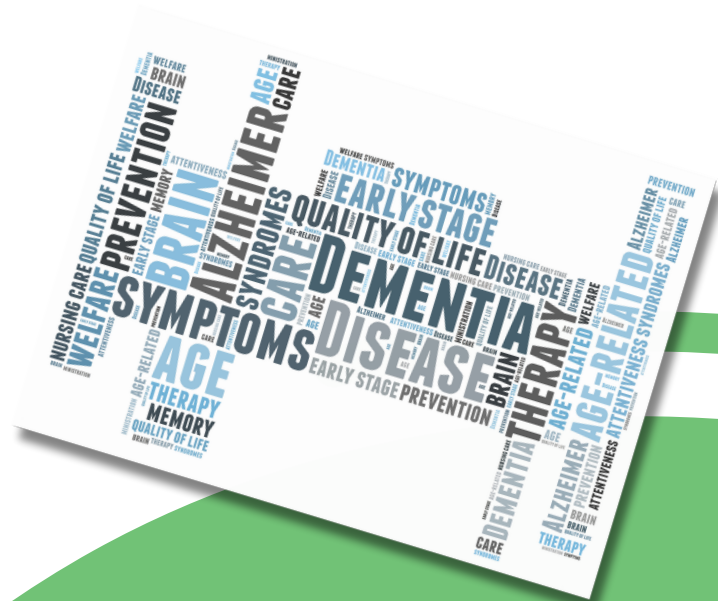


This workshop is designed to help attendees develop a basic appreciation for what happens in the brain due to some form of dementia. Specifically, attendees will discover the value in what remains as the condition progresses, as well as an introduction of supportive responses. The goal is to see that the person living with dementia is doing the best they can, rather than assuming they are simply not trying, or doing something on purpose. Attendees will also learn to identify for themselves when it is time to pause their agenda, such as a care task, and seek support for themselves or the person living with dementia.
