Directors Report:

2023 funding - we will receive Youth development funds for Jan to Sept 2023 then October 2023 till the following Sept 2024 as the state moves the federal fiscal year with these funds. The benefit of this will be that counties will know their allocations before they start planning the program year as allocations will come out April/May.

New/Old Business:

Homeless x-mas tree will be collecting items at the temporary DSS location at the old Glenfield School. We will be limiting items that we will accept this year due to limited storage space. Top items for request will be: Cash Donations, Tops/Walmart Gift cards, soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush/toothpaste.

We will avoid housewares and large items many of which we can obtain from other agencies. LCOI, salvation army and transitional living have resources and items we can obtain.

Ramona Carpenter has flyers and will have it announced on local media. Plan to run from Nov 28th to Dec 21st. If students plan to have a tree at their respective school they can coordinate with Ramona Carpenter.

Warming Center- a warming center at the Bethel Nazarene Church on Rt 12 in Lowville will open on Oct 24th. This will be a warm place for the homeless to stay at night. The Warming Center will provide access to case managers, to assist the client in finding housing and other services. As a result we may see a change in the use of our items from the homeless closet at DSS.
