

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lewis, at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 7th day of April, 1959, duly adopted on said day a Local Law, being Local Law # 2 of 1959, reading as follows:

"LOCAL LAW NO. 2 -YEAR 1959"

COUNTY OF LEWIS, NEW YORK

A LOCAL LAW to authorize payment of certain expenses of County Officers and Employees.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lewis, New York, as follows:


Section 1. Pursuant to Section 77-b of the General Municipal Law as amended, power is hereby delegated to the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to authorize County Officers and Employees to attend an official or unofficial convention or conference or meeting of duly constituted committees or any school conducted for the betterment of municipal or county government. Such authorization, if the same shall be granted by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, shall be in writing and signed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 2. All actual and necessary expenses of travel, meals, lodging and registration fee, incurred by any person duly authorized to attend a conference, meeting or school shall be a county charge against the proper appropriation item of the respective department and shall be paid upon presentation of a duly itemized voucher signed by the respective claimant and department head.

Section 3. This LOCAL LAW shall take effect thirty days after its adoption.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that such Local Law became effective May 7, 1959.
