Local Law No. 1 of the year 1962

A local law providing for continuity of County Government and that of its

elective and appointive officers.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the

Section 1. If, as the result of an attack, actual or imminent, or series of attacks by an enemy or a foreign nation upon the United States, the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Lewis County is unable to discharge the powers and duties of his office, or is absent from the County, then the member of the Board of Supervisors longest in service shall act as Chairman during such disability or absence. Should such member longest in service be unable to discharge the powers and duties of chairman, or be absent from the County, the member next longest in service shall act as Chairman during such disability or absence, and such progression shall continue so long as such disability or absence continues and there be members to act as Chairman. Such person shall have for such period the same powers and be subject to the same duties and limitations as the regularly elected Chairman of the Board. A member of the Board acting as Chairman under the aforesaid circumstances shall not receive the salary of Chairman while so acting, nor shall he receive any compensation for so acting other than the salary of his office as a member of the Board of Supervisors. Should two or more members of the Board of Supervisors, able to so act, have the same length of service as such members, the one to act as Chairman shall be selected by lot.

Section 2. If, as the result of such an attack, any of the elective or appointive officers of the County of Lewis is unable to discharge the powers and duties of his office, or is absent from the County, and there is no provision in the laws of the State of New York for designating a person to discharge the powers and duties of such office, the Board of Supervisors, or if vacancies or inability to serve or absence from the County have reduced its membership to less than a majority, then a majority of the remaining members of the Board of Supervisors shall appoint a person to discharge the powers and duties of such elective or appointive office during such disability or absence, and the person so appointed shall have and exercise all the powers and discharge all the duties, and be subject to all the provisions of law applicable to the officer whose place he shall supply, and shall receive such salary as shall be fixed by the members of the Board of Supervisors making such appointment.

Section 3. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing a certified copy hereof with the Lewis County Clerk, a certified copy hereof in the office of the State Comptroller, and three certified copies hereof in the office of the Secretary of State.
