Introduced by Supervisor Ralph A. Marmon, a member of the Reforestation Committee.

A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 3, Year 1963, County of Lewis to provide for the establishment of a bounty on porcupines and affix the amount thereof.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. Local Law No. 3, Year 1963, County of Lewis entitled "A Local Law to Establish a Bounty on Porcupines and Affix the Amount thereof." is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That a bounty of Fifty Cents (50¢) on each porcupine is to be paid by the County Treasurer of the County of Lewis.

Section 2. Evidence consisting of the two front paws of any destroyed porcupine shall be presented at the office of the Sheriff of the County of Lewis and the person entitled to the bounty shall thereafter make a written and notarized application in form satisfactory to the Sheriff, but at least containing details as to the time and place of destruction and the name and address of the person destroying same.

Section 3. If the Sheriff be satisfied, from the application presented, that the individual presenting same is entitled to the bounty, he shall issue a duplicate or copy of the application with his approval endorsed thereon, for presentation by said individual entitled, to the County Treasurer, who is authorized to make the bounty payment upon presentation of such copy or duplicate application properly endorsed by the Sheriff.

Section 4. That this Local Law shall take effect immediately.

Section 2. That this Local Law shall take effect immediately upon all proper legal requirements being met.
