COUNTY OF LEWIS

Introduced by Supervisor Paul Merz, Chairman of the County Officers and Employees Committee.

A local law creating the Office of Public Defender in and for the County of Lewis and otherwise treating of the position of Public Defender.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. That the Office of Public Defender in and for the County of Lewis be and said Office is hereby created.

Section 2. That J. Lawson Brown, an Attorney at Law, duly qualified to practice in the State of New York, who resides at Lowville, New York, be and he hereby is appointed to the Office of Public Defender.

Section 3. That the salary for such Office shall begin with the effective date of this local law and continue until the 31st day of December, 1966 at the rate of \$3,250.00 to be paid in regular monthly installments.

Section 4. That beginning with January 1, 1967 the salary for such Office shall be \$3,000.00 per year to be paid in regular monthly installments.

Section 5. That the within appointment shall be effective immediately and continue until December 31, 1967.

Section 6. That all succeeding appointments shall be for two-year terms beginning on the 1st days of January in even numbered years.

Section 7. That the within local law shall take effect immediately and upon compliance with all legal, necessary and statutory requirements.
