Introduced by Supervisor Irving J. Kraeger, as a member of the Board of Supervisors.

A local law providing for the enforcement of the amounts due to Lewis County Self-Insurance Plan upon a withdrawal of a participant.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. If, upon the withdrawal of a participant, from the Lewis County Self-Insurance Plan, such participant shall not, within the time limits set by this Board of Supervisors, pay any amount determined to be owed by said participant such amount shall be recovered by an action brought by the County or such amount shall be certified by the County Treasurer to the Board of Supervisors for credit to the County and charge to the participant in the next succeeding tax levy.

Section 2. That the within local law shall apply to all amounts whether now or hereafter owed by any participant.

Section 3. That the within local law shall take effect immediately upon all proper requirements being met.
