COUNTY OF LEWIS

Introduced by Legislator Irving Kraeger, Chairman of the Public Health Committee.

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING LEWIS COUNTY OFFICE FOR THE AGING.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. Establishment of the Lewis County Office for the Aging.

(a) For the purposes of carrying out the provisions of Article 19J of the Executive Law with reference to office for the Aging and services in connection therewith, there is hereby established a department of county government to be known as Lewis County Office for the Aging.

(b) The head of said Department shall be Director for the Office of the Aging in and for the County of Lewis and shall be appointed by the Lewis County Board of Legislators and shall serve at the pleasure of said Board. Such Director shall be in the unclassified service of the civil service.

Section 2. Salary of Director.

The salary of the Director shall be fixed by the Lewis County Board of Legislators and shall be payable by the County Treasurer. In addition, such Director shall receive all necessary expenses incurred while in the performance of his official duties, including a reasonable mileage allowance, as fixed by said Legislature, for the miles actually and necessarily traveled on official business by the use of his own automobile.

Section 3. Powers and Duties of Director.

(a) Shall have and perform all the powers and duties conferred on the Director of the Office of the Aging by the Executive Law and any other general or special law and shall perform such additional and related duties as may be prescribed and directed by the County Legislature. He shall have the supervision and control of all persons employed in the Office of the Aging.

(b) may appoint qualified persons to the positions of employment established from time to time by the County Legislature

for the Office of the Aging. He shall have the power to remove such appointed persons in accordance with applicable law.

(c) that he may, within the compensation schedule as adopted by the County of Lewis, from time to time fix the salary and compensation of employees under his direction.

(d) shall, with the written approval of the Public Health Committee of the County Legislature and within the amount appropriated by the County Legislature, appoint and employ such other persons as may be necessary, and fix the salary and compensation of such employees;

(e) may procure, at the expense of the County of Lewis a blanket undertaking from any duly authorized corporate surety covering the officers, clerks and employees in the Office of the Aging to indemnify the County of Lewis against losses through the failure of the officers, clerks and employees covered thereunder to faithfully perform their duties or to account properly for all monies or property received by virtue of the positions or employment;

(f) may, with the approval of the Public Health Committee of the County Legislature, adopt rules and regulations not inconsistent with law for the conduct of the affairs and business of the Office of the Aging.

(g) to advise and assist the Lewis County Board of Legislators in developing policies designed to help meet the needs of the aging and to encourage the full participation of the aging in society;

(h) to coordinate programs and activities relating to the aging;

(i) to cooperate with and assist political subdivisions in the development of local programs for the aging; and

(j) to render each year to the Lewis County Board of Legislators a written report of the activities and recommendations of the office for the aging.

Section 4. Powers of office.

(a) That the County of Lewis, by and through the Lewis County Office for the Aging and Director of the Lewis County Office for the Aging, shall have the powers to contract with counties, cities, towns, villages, school districts, or public or private nonprofit corporations, associations, institutions, or agencies concerned with the aging, for the operation and maintenance of programs for the aging.

(b) That Lewis County Office for the Aging shall have such other powers as may be given it by law, rule, regulation, resolution or ordinance.

Section 5. This local law shall take effect when all legal requirements have been met.
