A LOCAL LAW WITH REFERENCE TO THE RECRUITMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF PHYSICIANS AND THE EXPENDITURE OF COUNTY FUNDS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. It is the intent of this local law to promote the recruitment of physicians and to provide for the assistance, support and maintenance of physicians with the aid of County funds because of the severe and acute physician shortage in Lewis County. That this local law is meant to give such assistance, support and maintenance in order to make generally available medical services within proper confines.

Section 2. The County of Lewis is hereby authorized to appropriate and, through the Board of Managers of Lewis County General Hospital, expend county funds in cash or kind for physician recruitment, and is further authorized to appropriate and expend county funds in cash or kind for the purpose of contracting with physician placement groups or agencies for recruitment of physicians in the private or public sector and to enter into contracts with persons, corporations, associations, agencies or municipalities to carry into effect within the County of Lewis such program, all within applicable appropriations.

Section 3. The Board of Managers of Lewis County General Hospital shall have the authority, within applicable appropriations, to provide minimum gross income guarantees by contract for a period not to exceed two years for physicians specifically recruited under the physician recruitment program, and to appropriate funds for

brochures, travel expenses for physicians being recruited, and moving expenses of physicians specifically recruited by the county provided such physicians agree to practice in the County of Lewis for a specified period of time.

Section 4. The Board of Managers of Lewis County General Hospital shall have the authority for a period not to exceed two years to underwrite and make provisions for low rentals on offices as well as the furnishings for a full or partial consideration, or without consideration, secretarial, accounting and nurses services together with supplies, equipment and related items necessary or desirable in the practice of medicine.

Section 5. The within program is to be co-ordinated by the Administrator of Lewis County General Hospital. The office of the Administrator of Lewis County General Hospital shall serve as a central depository and clearing house for information pertaining to all aspects of physician recruitment, supplies and maintenance in the County of Lewis.

Section 6. That this local law shall take effect immediately.
