BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County
of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. That the Board of Legislators of the County
of Lewis and the Clerk thereof be and they hereby are authorized
to publish in summary, abstract or digest form all county local
laws after the effective date thereof, with such publication to
be in the manner as prescribed in Section 214, Subdivision 2 of
the County Law.

Section 2. That this local law is adopted pursuant to
the authority of Municipal Home Rule Law and is meant to modify,
in a consistent manner, Section 214, Subdivision 2 of the County
Law as it relates to the publication of the entire text of a
local law after the effective date thereof.

Section 3. That the within local law shall take
effect immediately.
