A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN SALARIES OF CERTAIN

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County
of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. That the salaries of the following officials
of the County of Lewis be and the same hereby are increased over
their present salaries and are set at the following:

Commissioner of Social Services	\$ 20,989
Election Commissioner (Democrat)	7,535
Election Commissioner (Republican)	7,535
Superintendent of Highways	23,054
Real Property Tax Director	14,423
Public Defender	9,149
County Attorney	11,794

Section 2. That the above officials are to receive the
above salaries until said salaries are duly amended by this Board.

Section 3. That the within local law shall take effect
May 18th, 1979, or 45 days after the adoption and legal require-
ments are met, whichever event shall occur latest.
