A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN SALARIES OF CERTAIN
LOCAL OFFICIALS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the
County of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. That the salaries of the following
officials of the County of Lewis be and the same hereby are
increased over their present salaries and are set at the
following:

Commissioner of Social Services	\$ 22,350
Election Commissioner (Republican)	7,900
Election Commissioner (Democrat)	7,900
Superintendent of Highways	24,500
Real Property Tax Director	16,320

Section 2. That the above officials are to receive
the above salaries until said salaries are duly amended by this
Board, either by local law or resolution duly adopted.

Section 3. That the within local law shall take
effect January 1st, 1980, or 45 days after the adoption and legal
requirements being met, whichever event shall occur latest.
