Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the

Introduced by Legislator Gary Buckingham, Chairman of the County Officers and Employees Committee.

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN SALARIES OF CERTAIN LOCAL OFFICIALS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. That the salaries of the following officials of the County of Lewis be and the same hereby are increased over their present salaries and are set at the following:

County Attorney		\$ 17,044
Commissioner of Social Services		25,117
Superintendent of Highways		27,387
Director of Real Property Tax Services		20,672
Election Commissioners - two	each	10,500
Civil Service Commissioners - three	each	1,350
Public Defender		14,000

Section 2. That all salaries herein affected, upon the adoption and consummation of this local law, shall be effective as of January 1st, 1985.

Section 3. That the above officials are to receive the above salaries until said salaries are duly amended by this Board either by local law or resolution duly adopted.

Section 4. That the within local law shall take effect January 1st, 1985, or 45 days after the adoption and legal requirements being met, whichever event shall occur latest.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)
