A LOCAL LAW WITH REFERENCE TO REGULATING THE DISPOSAL OF
MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE IN THE COUNTY OF LEWIS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County
of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. That, pursuant to §2706 of the Public
Authorities Law, the Board of Legislators of the County
of Lewis hereby adopts a local law regulating the disposal of
solid waste in the County of Lewis.

Section 2. That, commencing with the opening of the
Development Authority of the North Country Solid Waste
Management Facility, all solid waste generated or originated
within the County of Lewis or such part or parts thereof as
may be designated by resolution of this Board of Legislators,
shall be delivered to said Facility, on such terms and conditions
and subject to such regulations as the said Authority may prescribe.

Section 3. That the within local law shall take effect
immediately.
