Section 1. The Board of Managers of Lewis County General Hospital is hereby authorized to establish awards and scholarships in such manner as said Board of Managers may determine to provide financial assistance, including tuition, books, transportation, living expenses, fees and related expenses, for attendance by legal residents of this State who have attained the minimum age of 18 years for the study of health related disciplines and fields to obtain the necessary education to be qualified to fill those positions deemed in short personnel supply by said Lewis County General Hospital, conditioned upon the written promise of such award or scholarship holder to be employed by said Lewis County General Hospital for such period as said Board of Managers may fix, following completion of his or her studies.

Section 2. Each such award or scholarship shall entitle the recipient to such sum of money as may be fixed by such Board of Managers while in attendance at approved

SCHOOLS OR COLLEGES WITHIN THE STATE OF NEW YORK DURING A PERIOD AS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY SAID BOARD OF MANAGERS.

Section 3. Such awards and scholarships may be granted to both employees of Lewis County General Hospital in order to advance their training and education to the advantage of Lewis County General Hospital and also to those individuals not employed by said Lewis County General Hospital upon the written promise of such grantees to be employed by said Lewis County General Hospital in such capacity as may be determined by Lewis County General Hospital for a period of time and upon such terms and conditions as the Board of Managers may fix and determine.

Section 4. The County of Lewis shall appropriate annually such sums of money as said County may deem appropriate as may be necessary to defray the costs of such scholarships and awards, and moneys so appropriated shall be deemed appropriated for a lawful County purpose and shall be raised by the same methods as moneys required for other lawful County purposes.

Section 5. The Board of Managers be and said Board hereby is authorized to make and formulate written rules and regulations herein not inconsistent with this local law.

Section 6. Such awards and scholarships may be awarded to individual recipients both prior to entering an approved school or college and to those recipients who are already enrolled in an approved school or college.

Section 7. That the Board of Managers, for the year 1987 only, may approve such scholarships and awards for those who are already enrolled at an approved school or college within the State of New York prior to the enactment of this local law.

Section 8. That the within local law may, in the discretion of said Board of Managers, be used and applied independently of Local Law No. 3-1987, County of Lewis, being "A LOCAL LAW WITH REFERENCE TO ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOLS AND COLLEGES BY COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES."

Section 9. That the within local law shall take effect immediately upon all legal requirements being met.
