Introduced by Legislator Gary Buckingham, Chairman of the County Officers and Employees Committee.

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN SALARIES OF CERTAIN LOCAL OFFICIALS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. That the salaries of the following officials of the County of Lewis be and the same hereby are increased over their present salaries and are set at the following:

Real Property Tax Director	\$ 21,500
Election Commissioners (each)	12,000
Social Services Commissioner	30,500
Superintendent of Highways	32,000

Section 2. That all salaries herein affected, upon the adoption and consummation of this local law shall be effective as of January 1st, 1988.

Section 3. That the above officials are to receive the above salaries until said salaries are duly amended by this Board either by local law or resolution duly adopted.

Section 4. That the within local law shall take effect January 1st, 1988 or 45 days after the adoption and legal requirements being met, whichever event shall occur latest.

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. 1 of 19 88 County of the City of Lewis was duly passed by the Board of Legislators (Name of Legislative Body) on November 23rd 19 87 not disapproved and was approved by the Elective Chief Executive Officer* repassed after disapproval on January 7th 19 88 in accordance with the applicable provisions of law. That the County of Lewis does not have an Elective Chief Executive Officer within the meaning of §2, subd. 4 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and Statute of Local Government.

*Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis or, if there be none, the chairman of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village or the supervisor of a town where such officer is vested with power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19 of the City of having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of §³⁶§³⁷ of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the ^{special}general election held on 19..... became operative.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)
