A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN SALARIES OF CERTAIN
LOCAL OFFICIALS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the
County of Lewis as follows:

Section 1. That the salaries of the following offi-
cials of the County of Lewis be and the same hereby are
increased over their present salaries and are set at the
following:

Superintendent of Highways	\$ 36,750
Commissioner of Social Services	34,912
Real Property Tax Director	25,200
Commissioners of Election (each)	13,650

Section 2. That all salaries herein affected, upon
the adoption and consummation of this local law shall be
effective as of January 1st, 1990.

Section 3. That the above officials are to receive
the above salaries until said salaries are duly amended by
this Board either by local law or resolution duly adopted.

Section 4. That the within local law shall take
effect January 1st, 1990, or 45 days after the adoption and
legal requirements being met, whichever event shall occur
latest.
