Local Law No. 3 of the Year 2000

A Local Law Repealing Local Law No. 5 for the Year 1984 in Order to Allow the Veteran's Exemption Authorized by Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law.

Be it enacted by the **Lewis County Board of Legislators** of the **County of Lewis**, as follows:

Section 1. Purpose.

The purpose of this Local Law is to exercise the option provided in Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York for the County of Lewis, to determine and to elect to grant the Veteran's Exemption authorized in that Section.

Section 2. Local Administrative Action.

- A. Local Law Number 5 of the Year 1984 of the County of Lewis is hereby repealed.
- B. Pursuant to Section 458-a (4) of Article of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the County of Lewis hereby provides that the Veteran's Exemption authorized by Section 458-a shall be permitted or allowed upon or against any real property subject to taxation within and by the County of Lewis as provided in Section 458-a, as amended.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State and all necessary legal requirements being met.

I hereby certify that the Local Law annexed hereto, designated as Local Law No. _____ of 19__, of the County, City, Town, Village of _____ was duly passed by the _____ on _____, 19__, and was approved/not disapproved/repassed after disapproval by the _____ on _____, 19__. Such Local Law was subject to permissive referendum and no valid petition requesting such referendum was filed as of _____, 19__, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.


