Local Law No. 4 of the Year 2002**

A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1970 of the County of Lewis.
(Insert Title)

Be it enacted by the Lewis County Board of Legislators of the County of Lewis, as follows:

SECTION I. TITLE

A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1970 of the County of Lewis (Mass Gathering Local Law).

SECTION II. AMENDMENT.

Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1970, of the County of Lewis, being a Local Law relating to, regulating, and licensing outdoor public musical entertainments, amusements, and assemblies in excess of 10,000 persons: Establishing licensing procedures and fees therefore; and prescribing offenses and penalties, hereby is amended as follows:

Section 10 of Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1970 of the County of Lewis is hereby deleted and the following Section 10 is hereby inserted:

“Section 10: This Local Law shall not apply to the area of any Village or Town within the County of Lewis during such time as such Village or Town is regulating or licensing the conduct of outdoor public musical entertainments, amusements and assemblies.

In addition, this Local Law shall not apply to any land-use in any area of any Village or Town within the County of Lewis when such land-use is regulated by Town or Village Zoning Laws, or other Town or Village Land-Use Regulations, including specifically, but not limited to, the Town of New Bremen Site Plan Review Zoning Law.”

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY.

If any part of the Local Law shall be judicially declared to be invalid, void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, all unaffected provisions hereof shall survive such declaration, and this Local Law shall remain in full force and effect as if the invalidated portions had not been enacted.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State’s Office.
